



SUPPLY OF BIRDTRACK DATA TO COUNTY AND LOCAL BIRD RECORDERS

BirdTrack is a web-based bird listing and recording project organised by the BTO on behalf of BTO, RSPB and BirdWatch Ireland (“the BirdTrack Partners”). The BirdTrack partners are keen to make both ornithological data and associated personal data on observers, collected through BirdTrack, available to County and Local Bird Recorders provided that the observers have given permission for such onward transmission. Ornithological data supplied by BirdTrack may be used freely and published by individuals and organizations involved in bird recording in line with normal practice. Please ensure that BirdTrack is acknowledged for supplying such data. Personal data may only be used to contact observers about ornithological data verification and about the use and acknowledgement of their details unless they have given direct agreement for other uses. Ornithological data supplied by BirdTrack may also be used to fulfil data requests relating to your own recording area. Please refer any requests for BirdTrack data relating to larger areas to the BTO.

2. Forwarding information to local bird recorders

Once such data have been supplied responsibility for their use rests with the local bird recorders concerned and not with the BTO.
