Where:

Directions: The main access route is via the York to Scarborough road, A64. Follow the slip-road signs to Malton (town centre). At the traffic lights in the town centre turn RIGHT. Follow the road to and straight over the railway crossing baring to the left. At the first mini roundabout turn RIGHT into Wold Street & Langton Road. The College is approximately ½ mile on the LEFT hand side.

Alternatively:

- From Hull/Humber Bridge use the A164 to Beverley and pick up the B1248 to Bainton, Wetwang & Norton/Malton. Pick up the signs for Langton and follow the directions to the College.
- From Teeside go to Stokesley (south of Middlesbrough) and pick up the B1257 to Helmsley & Malton then follow the original directions straight over the traffic lights in the town centre to the railway crossing.
