MAMMAL RECORDING

Although the main aim of the EWBS is to record birds, Brown Hare and habitats, it would be useful if you could record sightings of mammals on your EWBS square.

- While carrying out your bird surveys, please count all live mammals seen during your EWBS visits.
- Any estimate of the numbers of a particular species you see on your survey visits (no matter how rough) is more useful than recording 'too many to count', 'present', etc.
- Note down mammal records on your Field Recording Sheets alongside your bird records Brown Hares need to be recorded.
- There is no need to make special visits to count mammals, nor to record them in distance bands except Brown Hare.

Did you look out for mammals? Recording mammals is optional. Please enter 'Y' if you looked out for mammals/ signs, even if you saw none (a nil return is just as valuable as a square with lots of mammals and signs recorded), or recycle this form if you did not participate in mammal recording.

Visit and section. This form covers all four visits. Enter the visit and one transect section (1 - 10), per row, for each mammal and observation except Brown Hare.
